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Mainstreaming Gender Data

- Gender bias occurs because stereotypes about gender—for example, that women are caregivers rather than commuters—become implicit in the data collection methods.
- The photo at right depicts a woman traveling with a child strapped to her back. If researcher or planner do not capture her traveling while caregiving, this type of mobility data would never get collected.



Mobility of Women: mismatch between women needs and transport system

 Unsatisfied by gender: housewives who are, by definition, the caregiving group of population, are the most affected, as well as employed women who suffer from time poverty









 Methodology: identification of unmet travel needs through travel time threshold and level of satisfaction


 Social poverty and transport poverty: two different poverties with different solutions

Gender and cultural background strongly affect mobility,




Manual of digital interfaces and tools taking into consideration socially vulnerable- to-exclusion people needs.

INDIMO Pilots within Community of Practices

- 1. Galilee pilot and app aim, deployed by Technion:
 - to improve digital mobility services for Arab women, taking into consideration their specific cultural and gender restrains.
 - to expand their mobility widen their academic, employment and lifestyle opportunities.





INDIMO Pilots within Community of Practices

- 1. Berlin Pilot deployed by door-to door aims:
 - serve women migrants and low-income that are care-takers of children.
 - take place in the district of Marzahn-Hellersdorf because it has one of the highest percentages of families per household in Berlin and the care-givers mobility is quite problematic.

Gender, Transport, Human Rights and Climate Change: 5 recommendations

- Incorporate women into the planning process
- Designing complete streets for walking, facilitating cycling, intermediate modes, and green, weather-resistant public transport.

- 4. Provide inclusive transport services that meet the diverse needs of travel beyond business travel
- Enabling progress in funding, education and outreach for inclusive sustainable mobility
